Other – other domestic animals (rabbits, turtles, guinea pigs, goats, etc.) Wild - wildlife (raccoons, squirrels, bats, etc.) Animal Control – stray animals brought in by an Animal Control Officer Public Stray – stray animals brought in by a member of the public TNR – feral cat accepted for TNR: Trap-Neuter-Return to original location Surrender - animals brought in by their owners who no longer wish to keep them Quarantine - animals that are brought in for Rabies observation Returned – animal adopted through Butte Humane Society and returned Owner Request - animal brought in by owner requesting euthanasia or disposal County – animals brought in from an unincorporated area of the City Drop – animals that have been left at the shelter while the shelter is closed CAS Return – animal adopted through the City and returned Carry Over – animals remaining in the shelter from the previous month Remaining – animals remaining at the shelter/in foster care at the end of the month RTO – animals returned to (claimed by) their owner BHS –animals placed in the Butte Humane Society adoption program Rescue – animals transferred to other rescue organizations/wildlife rehab center Transferred – animals transferred to another animal control agency (usually Butte County) Released – wildlife released to wild/cat TNR
