Explanation of Terms:

- Animal Control – stray animals brought in by an Animal Control Officer
- Public Stray – stray animals brought in by a member of the public
- Surrender – animals brought in by their owners who no longer wish to keep them
- Quarantine – animals that are brought in for Rabies observation
- Owner Request – animal brought in by owner requesting euthanasia or disposal
- County – animals brought in from an unincorporated area of the City
- Drop – animals that have been left at the shelter while the shelter is closed
- Carry Over – animals remaining in the shelter from the previous year
- RTO – animals returned to (claimed by) their owner
- BHS – animals placed in the Butte Humane Society adoption program
- Rescue – animals transferred to other rescue organizations
- Transferred – animals transferred to another animal control agency (usually Butte County)
- RTF – Returned to finder if not claimed by owner
- Rehab – animals transferred to wildlife rehab center
- Remaining – animals remaining at the shelter/in foster care at the end of the year
- \*Other includes other domestic animals, including livestock and exotics, as well as wildlife
