Explanation of Terms:

- Other – other domestic animals (rabbits, turtles, guinea pigs, goats, etc.)
- Wild – wildlife (raccoons, squirrels, bats, etc.)
- Animal Control – stray animals brought in by an Animal Control Officer
- Public Stray – stray animals brought in by a member of the public
- TNR – feral cat accepted for TNR: Trap-Neuter-Return to original location
- Surrender – animals brought in by their owners who no longer wish to keep them
- Quarantine – animals that are brought in for Rabies observation
- Returned – animal adopted through Butte Humane Society and returned
- Owner Request – animal brought in by owner requesting euthanasia or disposal
- County – animals brought in from an unincorporated area of the City
- Drop – animals that have been left at the shelter while the shelter is closed
- CAS Return – animal adopted through the City and returned
- Carry Over – animals remaining in the shelter from the previous month
- Remaining – animals remaining at the shelter/in foster care at the end of the month
- RTO – animals returned to (claimed by) their owner
- BHS – animals placed in the Butte Humane Society adoption program
- Rescue – animals transferred to other rescue organizations/wildlife rehab center
- Transferred – animals transferred to another animal control agency (usually Butte County)
- Released – wildlife released to wild/cat TNR
